Description of Bills

HB 2326 (signed)

Prohibits state agencies and local governments from maintaining information on gun owners.

HB 2455 (signed)

Clarifies that firearms that have been "surrendered" or "otherwise" received may not be destroyed by the state or local governments. They must be sold.

SCR 1015 (passed)

A resolution by the Legislature supporting the Second Amendment. House vote was 18 to 12. Senate vote was 33 to 21 with 6 not voting.
